SMALL VEHICLES

Generally compact passenger vehicles with 2–5 seats and smaller interior space.

Includes:

Hatchbacks (3–door & 5–door), City cars, Micro cars, Compact hybrids, Compact sedans, Subcompact sedans, 2–door coupes, Small sports coupes, 2–seat convertibles, Small soft tops, Compact EVs

Examples:

- Toyota Corolla Hatch
- Mazda 2
- Hyundai i30
- Suzuki Swift
- Volkswagen Polo

MEDIUM VEHICLES

Standard family–sized vehicles with moderate interior space.

Includes:

Mid–size sedans, Standard 4–door passenger cars, Compact SUVs, Mid–size SUVs (5–seat), Station wagons, Touring wagons, 4–door dual cab utilities, With or without tub cover, Without heavy tray setups

Examples:

- Toyota Camry
- Mazda CX-5
- Hyundai Tucson
- Ford Ranger (dual cab)
- Nissan X-Trail

LARGE VEHICLES

Vehicles with significant interior space, third rows, extended bodies, or large cargo areas.

Includes:

7–seater SUVs, Full–size SUVs, 4WD wagons, Passenger vans, Commercial vans, Dual cab with canopy, Single cab with tray setup, Work vehicles with toolboxes, Modified touring setups, 7–8 seater MPVs

Examples:

- Toyota LandCruiser
- Toyota Prado
- Ford Motor Company Everest
- Nissan Patrol
- Hyundai Staria
- Mercedes–Benz Group Sprinter
